he's coming down to poo!





Fungi


These smell like rotting food.

So beautiful! Watch out for that giant bill!




Spiders

Anaconda


The green anaconda is the largest snake in the world! It eats deer, birds and even jaguars!

Make a circle shape with your sticks and tape together.










Sellotape them together and put them inside the bottle.
